

## **Notes**

Flute:


- 1. all grace notes precede beat
- 2. explosive "t" sound with tongue; no subsequent breath
- 3. flz. = flutter tongue

 $n \longrightarrow flz.$  = gradual shift from normal to flz.

4. b = very breathy

 $n \longrightarrow b$  = gradual shift from normal tone to very breathy  $b \longrightarrow n$  tone or vice-versa

5. X = blow through flute without producing tone



Percussion:

- 1.  $\downarrow$  = let vibrate  $\Rightarrow$  = damp
- 2. tom-tom mute = thick towel placed on top of drum; strike drum through towel

Piano:


